Registering for your text:

1. www.phschool.com/access/index.html
Use this address only to register
2. Click “covered titles”
3. Choose *Campbell Biology 8e AP* Edition*
4. Click “student registration”
5. Accept enduser license agreement
6. Create a log-in name—check rules. You should use an email address.
7. Create a password—check the rules.
8. Access code:

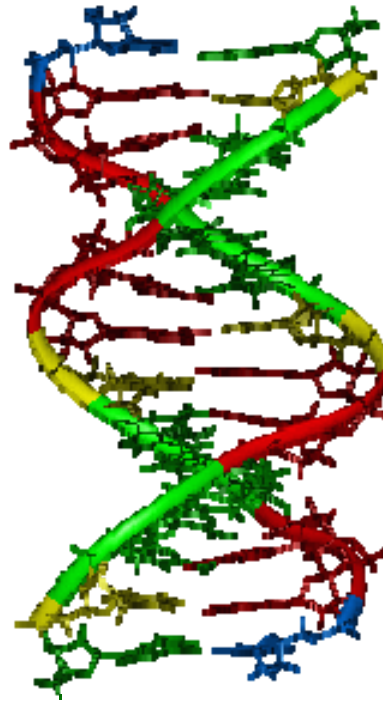
Enter the appropriate personal information.

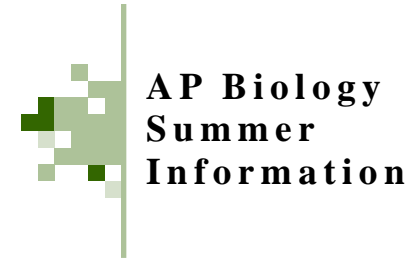
click on the *Campbell 8th AP Edition* icon, enter your login information and navigate to the appropriate chapter or find the ebook icon.



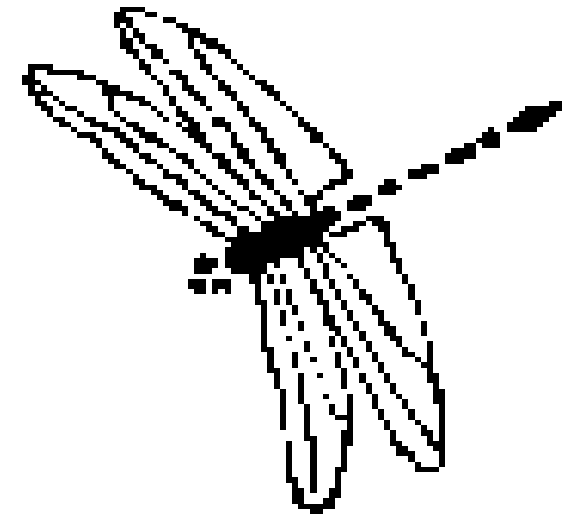

The summer reading will include Chapters 51-56 of the online Campbell Biology 8th AP edition. There will be regular online assessments using a service called Webassign to check your progress. Grades will be taken for these assignments.

In order to do well in this class it is necessary for you to average 10 pages of reading each school night (during the school year). The best way to insure that you will do well on the AP exam is to **read the book**. This is not casual reading, you may have to read a paragraph more than once before it begins to make sense. If you have difficulty with a section, write down your questions and bring them to class in August.

To enroll in Webassign, log on to www.webassign.net/login.html

“I HAVE A CLASS KEY” then enter the class key information shown to the right. After you enter the class key information a verification screen will appear with your instructor and class information. If this looks correct continue on to create an account. If you have used Webassign before, click on the button “I already have a Webassign account” and continue. You will be able to use your same username and password. If you have not used Webassign before click on the “I need to create a Webassign account” and then click continue. You will be asked to create a user name and password. Write down your user name, institution and password. **YOU MUST RECORD THESE IN AT LEAST TWO PLACES. DO NOT RELY ON YOUR MEMORY, WRITE THEM DOWN.** Also, if you are new to Webassign please be aware that you must click on the link to an assignment to access that assignment. Once you are enrolled you will use the login screen to access the Webassign site, For more information you can click on “**guide**” for more detailed instructions about how to use the service. If you run into difficulty email your GSMST instructor. **DO NOT** email Webassign, they will refer you back to me. Complete the Introductory Assignment. If you have any difficulty contact your instructor. Although the assignments have deadlines, during the summer, there are no penalties for extensions. To request an extension, please be aware of the warning you see when you

click on an overdue assignment. If you look at the key before requesting an extension you will not be able to request an extension, so request the extension and then enter the assignment after the extension has been granted.

All assignments will be available at the beginning of the summer so you can do them ahead of schedule if you wish. If you are traveling, I suggest you print off the assignments before you leave and then request an extension when you return to enter your responses.
